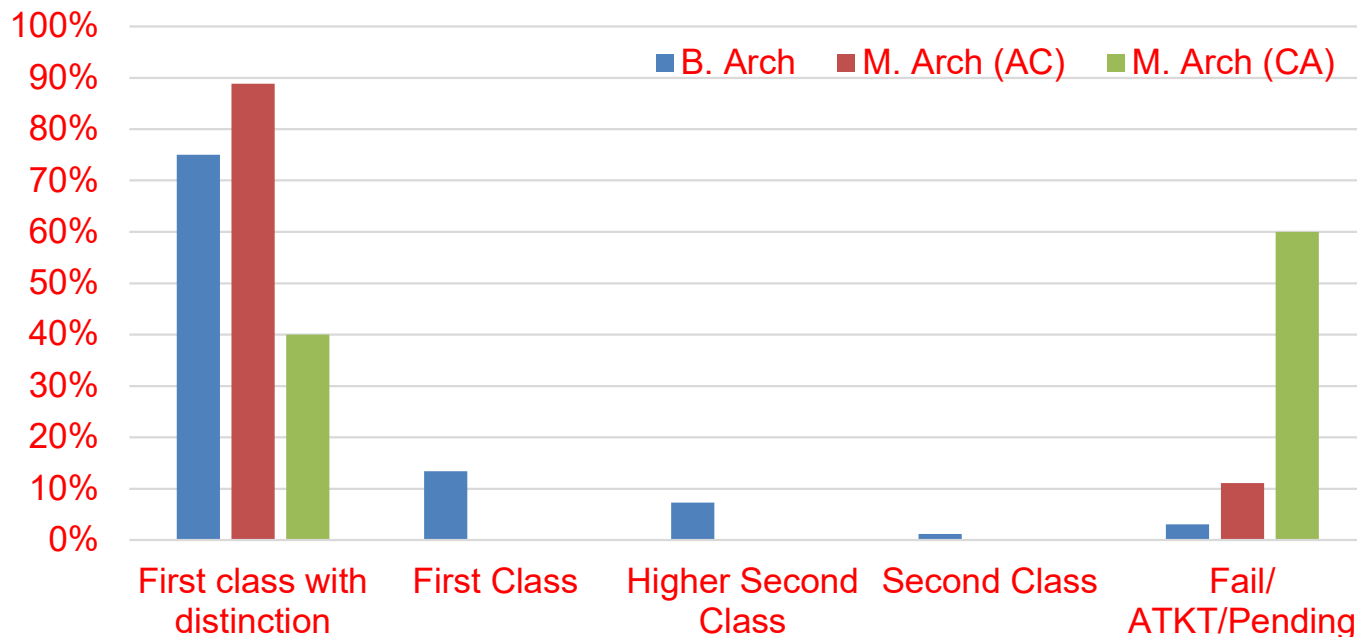

WILD LIFE RESORT AT UTTARAKHAND



This design is inspired from local context of Uttarakhand, the materials, climate response, and their functions. The very well known Jim Corbett National park is situated near to the site. This resort is designed for people visiting the wildlife sanctuary, with a healthy environment. The climate of Uttarakhand is Cold and Cloudy.

The designing is done along the contours which help in capturing maximum morning sunlight as the climate is cold and cloudy. Green spaces are created along the pathway and the stream. A stepped profile is created in elevation. Services can be placed at the north – east portion.


Keeping in mind the climate of Uttarakhand design must be done in such strategies :

Large Building Blocks are placed in long linear pattern, to allow max sunlight in. Buildings are placed along the contours in stepped terrace. Sloping Chhajjas or overhang roofing is provided to protect against heavy rain. Thinking about the local context, the materials like timber is used. While designing local context can't be left behind, even some of the structural elements can be used which are used locally

About the Design Concept

'Simplicity and good experience' as the design concept. Keeping in mind the local context, traditional aspects, social, cultural, the design is done with a fusion of modern and vernacular design. As the name suggests simplicity, local and traditional elements are incorporated. Designed for people keeping in mind their requirements, and hence the resorts represents a balance between traditional and modern construction.

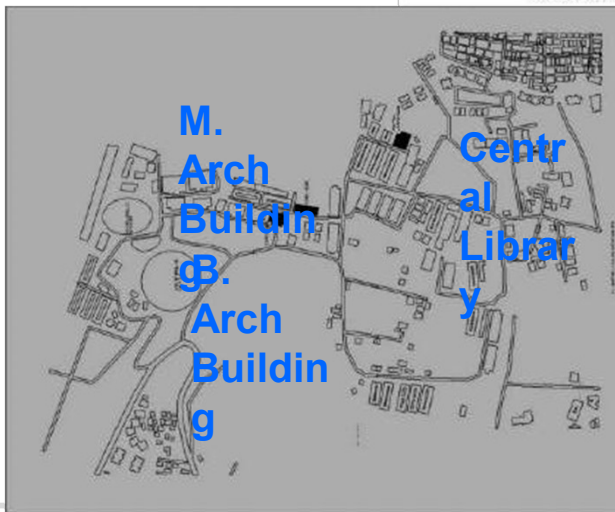

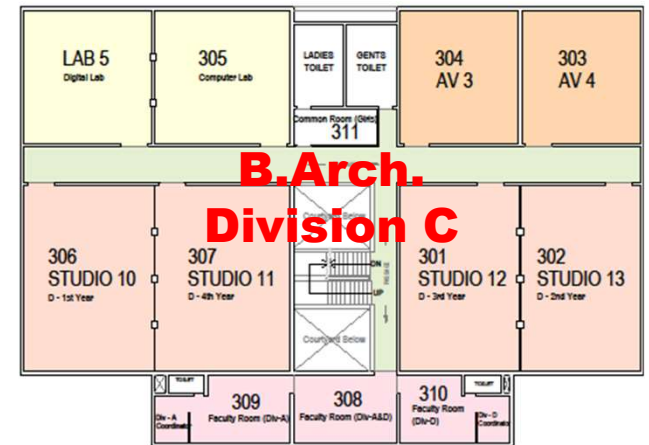

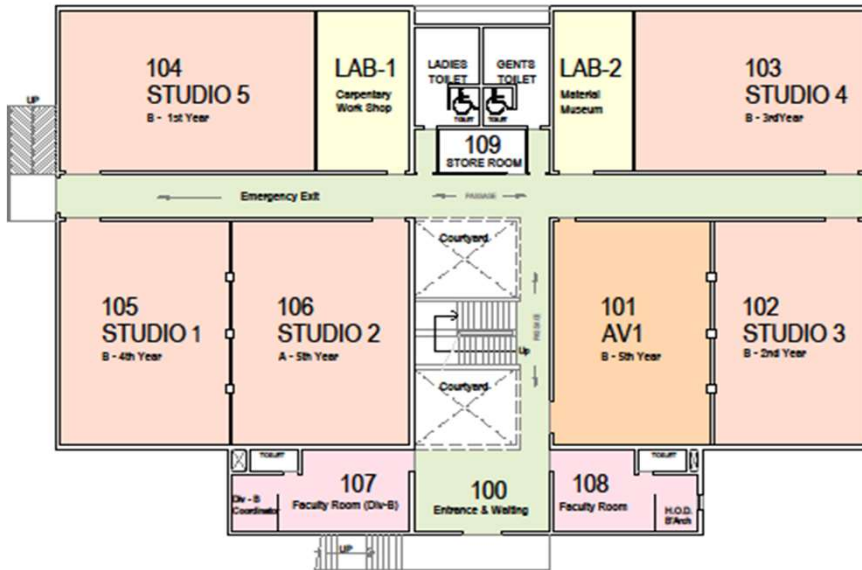

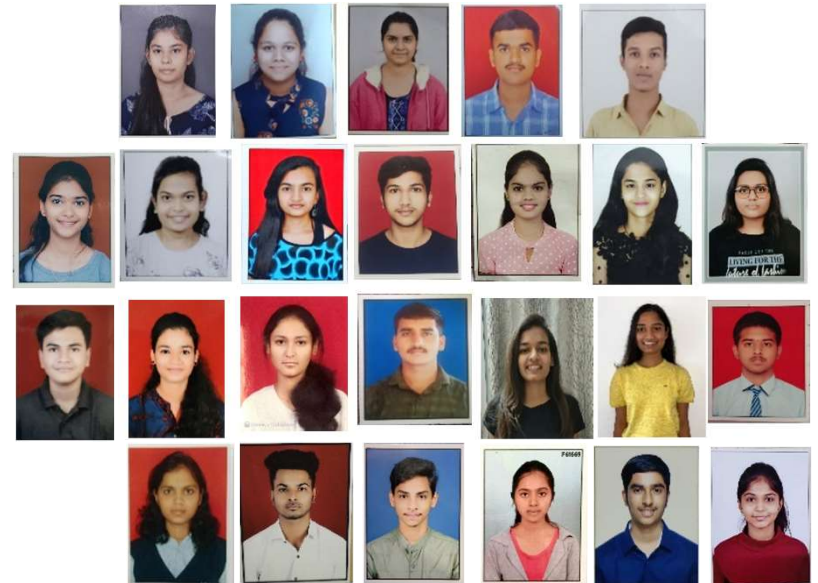

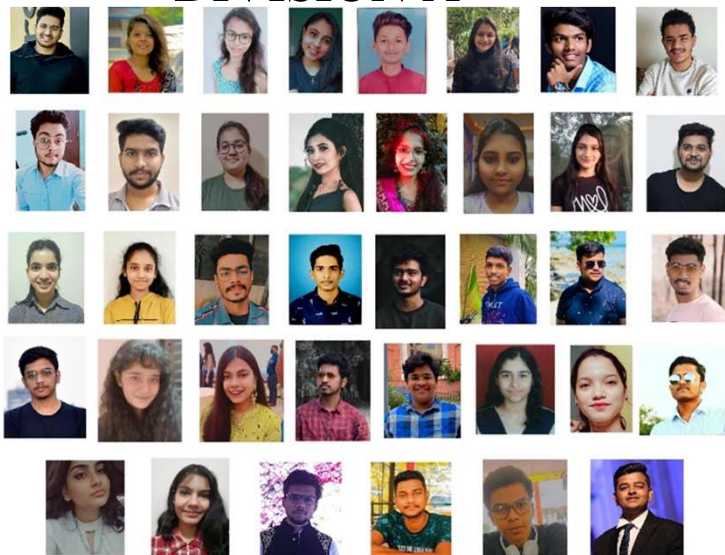
