OATH CEREMONY

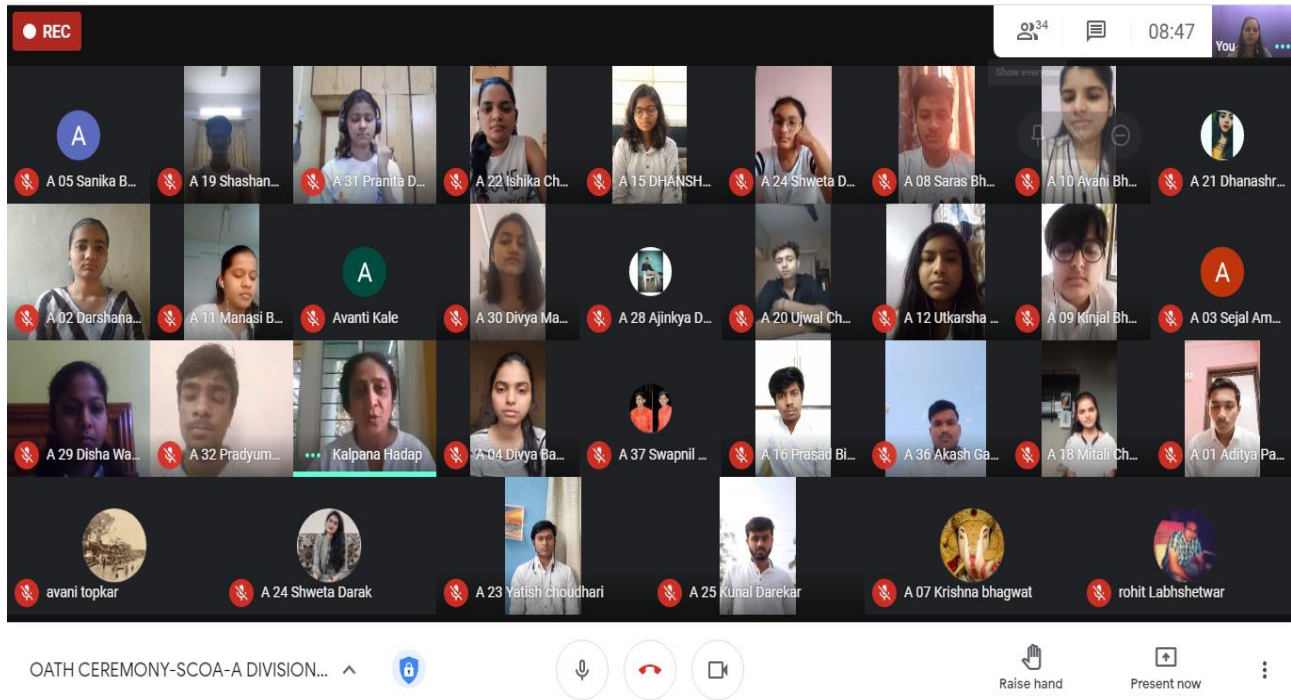
Topic: Oath ceremony for first year A Div students.
